The internship program is developed to give the interns:

- 1. as much knowledge possible about sailing and the industry;
- 2. joining our RYA practical and theory courses;
- 3. being an essential part of our team on shore;
- 4. becoming the ambassador for women in sailing in Antiqua.

By the end of the program, the interns will gain knowledge about a sailing organisation's management, receive RYA sailing certifications, acquire practical skills on sailboat maintenance, have some racing practice, and most importantly become a member of the sailing community in Antiqua and worldwide.

The outcome of the program is individual and is directly linked to how much time and work you are committed to putting in. We are interested in supporting enthusiastic women interested in making changes not only in their professional life, but also willing to make a difference in local community - educating, empowering, and inspiring other women from our beautiful island. We want this internship program to be an equal exchange: your motivation and passion will be fueling the level of knowledge we will be able to give back. We are here to guide, help, become a platform for your sailing passion, ready to make a difference together!

With this program, we wish to create an inclusive environment for local community, decrease the stereotyped gender gap in the industry, and learn from each other. We hope the program will inspire local females to explore the growing sailing community in Antigua, meet likeminded women sailors, and embrace the opportunities that the program will bring along the way. Female candidates who can apply:

• Citizens of Antiqua and Barbuda







- At least 18 years old
- Ability to swim
- None or very little experience in sailing
- Availability during working hours 2 days per week to work at the school's base
- Availability for 5 consecutive days during each one of the sailing and theory courses
- Commitment to the whole duration of the program
- Motivation and ability to work on individual projects
- Enthusiasm and strong sense of community

Program includes:

- Practical and theory sailing training from RYA Competent Crew level up to RYA Coastal Skipper certification
- Everyday tasks at the School Office assisting instructors, base managers, marketing
- Learning boat and sailing base maintenance
- Learning and crewing on charters, RYA Exams
- Participating in local Regattas
- Participating in planning activities for the season
- Individual local community-based project of your choice

Second Star Sailing provides:

- Free of charge participation in following courses: Competent Crew, Day Skipper Practical, Day Skipper Theory, Skills Week, Racing Week, Powerboat Level 2, First Aid, Diesel Engine, VHF Radio, Special courses and workshops.
- Books and online materials required for the courses
- Sailing safety gear
- Flexible schedule
- After completing 7 full months of the program, interns should have enough knowledge to qualify for a job in yachting industry, sufficient certification to charter a boat for holidays or work as a skipper on different sailboats.

- Application deadline June 15th, 2023
- Start of the program October 16th, 2023
- End of the program June 30th, 2024
- Location Antigua, Jolly Harbour.
