



SECOND STAR SAILING SUMMER CAMP TERMS & CONDITIONS

June 30 – July 11, Jolly Harbour, Antigua

Second Star Sailing is committed to providing a high-quality sailing education experience. To ensure transparency and clarity, the following Terms & Conditions outline the enrolment, payment, refund, and participation policies for the Summer Camp program. By enrolling in this program, participants and their parents/legal guardians agree to adhere to these terms.

1. ENROLLMENT AND ADMISSIONS POLICIES

Enrollment in the Second Star Sailing Summer School is conducted on a first-come, first-served basis. Once an application form is submitted, an email will be sent to the applicant to schedule a joint phone call detailing the next steps in the enrolment process with Second Star Sailing representative, parent/legal guardian and the applicant.

Participants with any medical conditions that may impact their ability to participate must disclose this information upon enrolment. A medical review may be required to assess the participant's suitability for the program. Providing accurate and up-to-date medical information is mandatory. Failure to disclose relevant medical history may result in denied enrolment or dismissal from the program without refund.

Second Star Sailing programs require participants to meet specific physical and mental preparedness levels. It is the responsibility of each participant and their family to review the program's demands and ensure they are adequately prepared.

To secure participation, all required forms and tuition payments must be completed within the designated timeframe. Failure to submit the required documentation or payments may result in the cancellation of the participant's enrolment without refund.

2. DEPOSIT & TUITION PAYMENTS

To secure a place in the program, a deposit of 25% (\$1,187 USD) is required at the time of enrolment. The deposit is refundable until April 1st, 2025; after this date, deposits become non-refundable. Full tuition payment is required by April 30th, 2025.

Deposit and rest of the tuition payment is made through our booking system on the website.

3. REFUND POLICY

Due to the limited availability of spaces and the logistical planning required, Second Star Sailing enforces a strict no-refund policy. Once a participant reserves a spot, that space cannot be offered to another applicant. As a result, no refunds will be issued for cancellations, dismissals, or early departures for any reason.

- **Cancellations between April 2nd and April 30th will incur** forfeit the deposit fee.

- **Cancellations between April 30th and May 15th** will incur a forfeit of 50% of the fee
- **Cancellations after May 15th** will result in the forfeiture of the full tuition amount.
- **All cancellations must be submitted in writing.**

We highly recommend that participants purchase travel insurance to cover any unforeseen circumstances.

4. PROGRAM MODIFICATIONS & CANCELLATIONS

Second Star Sailing reserves the right to modify or cancel the program due to unforeseen circumstances, including but not limited to:

- Adverse weather conditions
- Safety concerns
- Insufficient enrolment
- Travel restrictions or other force majeure events

In the event of cancellation due to low enrolment, participants will receive a full refund of their tuition fees. However, no refunds will be issued for cancellations resulting from force majeure events such as natural disasters, political unrest, pandemics, or any other situations beyond our control. Participants are encouraged to purchase tuition protection and travel insurance to mitigate financial risks.

5. PARTICIPANT DISMISSAL

Second Star Sailing reserves the right to dismiss any participant who:

- Fails to adhere to program policies and safety guidelines.
- Engages in disruptive or inappropriate behaviour.
- Fails to meet the program's physical or behavioural requirements.
- Violates any terms outlined in the participation agreement.

Dismissal from the program will result in the forfeiture of all tuition fees, and no refunds will be issued.

6. ADDITIONAL COSTS

The program tuition does not include airfare to and from Antigua. Any additional costs incurred due to early departure, medical evacuation, travel changes, or personal emergencies will be the responsibility of the participant and their family. These costs may include but are not limited to:

- Medical treatment and evacuation
- Flight change fees or rebooking charges
- Transportation and accommodation for early or late departures
- Any expenses incurred by staff members accompanying a participant, if applicable



7. PAYMENT AUTHORIZATION

By enrolling in the program, participants and/or their parents/legal guardians authorize Second Star Sailing to charge their designated payment method according to the terms outlined in this document.

All payments are final and non-refundable except as specified in the refund policy.

8. TRAVEL & MEDICAL INSURANCE REQUIREMENT

All participants must have valid medical insurance that covers international travel. For US-based participants, we strongly recommend purchasing tuition protection and travel insurance to safeguard against unforeseen circumstances. International participants should obtain equivalent insurance coverage.

Second Star Sailing is not responsible for any costs incurred due to illness, injury, or travel disruptions.

By submitting an enrolment request and making payment, participants and their guardians acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions outlined above. Second Star Sailing is committed to providing a safe, educational, and enriching experience, and adherence to these policies ensures a smooth and successful program for all participants.
